The Broadcast Induction session is a one (1) night training session covering all the important information needed to begin Broadcasting or to become involved in Radio 4EB activities. This course is held on the first Tuesday night of each month. The session will cover Workplace Health and Safety, Evacuation and Emergency Procedures, Broadcast Requirements and Regulations, ACMA requirements, Code of Practice for Community Broadcasters, CBF funding Compliance, Sponsorship Guidelines, APRA music requirements, 4EB By-Laws and information on Defamation.

Please note: All new broadcasters about to take this training session and future panel training sessions will be required to pay two years membership at the beginning to ensure community support and commitment to your allocated language group. All training applications must be approved by the Language Group Convenor.
