
## Radiothon News

## Radio 4EB and GLOBAL Digital - **It's all about the language**

Welcome to another year of broadcasting on Radio 4EB and GLOBAL and a new year of training new broadcasters in using the Panel for their programs.

The beginning of the year is always popular for broadcasters to begin training and this year is no different with all training positions for Monday night and Thursday afternoon filling up quickly. This is a good sign showing growth in all groups with lots

of young broadcasters too showing an interest in communicating to their communities.

I am now collecting applications for the next round of Panel Training courses due to begin in March. This is a great time for each group convenor to check on the availability of panel operators and to encourage broadcasters to undertake the panel course when ready.

This is also a good time to check that all sponsorship is being played by your broadcasters and panel operators during the programs especially during pre-recorded programs. If anyone in your group is unsure I am happy to spend some time with you to ensure this practice is carried out correctly so that we can see on the daily reports all sponsorships are played.

On the sponsorship program please make sure you click on the start session and not Preview session. Please select the right studio number and program. Download and move sponsorships to Mairlist program to be played. At the end of your program click on Finish Session before logging

off the computer.

We are now adding some sponsorship to a few GLOBAL programs and so it is important for you to check whether you have sponsorships to be played. As both GLOBAL studio do not have a second computer you are asked to check for sponsorships on the library computers by opening up the Intranet site and selecting Studio, the last item on the list. Once you know the sponsorship number you can locate these the old way through Mairlist under Studio Folder and Sponsorships.

Procedure:

1. Log on
2. Select date, program and studio
3. Click on START SESSION
4. Click download and move sponsorships across to Mairlist
5. Click on Finish session
6. Log off

If you have any questions please let the office know as we need to be able to guarantee paying clients that all sponsorships will go to air as per sponsorship contracts.


